

Philip Fitzgerald is Chief Impact Officer of Philadelphia Foundation, leading initiatives that bring together corporate, civic, nonprofit, government, and community stakeholders to create sustainable solutions with particular emphasis on economic mobility, community safety, and youth development. Phil has spent his career building cross-sector partnerships to address community challenges and his commitment to community development extends through earlier roles.

Previously, Phil served as SVP, Senior Program Officer at Citi Foundation, where he led the Community Progress Makers initiative, deploying over \$50 million to support community organizations driving economic opportunity across the US. His earlier tenure with Philadelphia Foundation spanned eight years, during which he oversaw discretionary grantmaking, scholarships, private foundation services, and special initiatives. His career began in education, preparing learners for high school equivalency exams and teaching English to speakers of other languages in Philadelphia and abroad.
